

**LANCASTER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
JANUARY 6, 2020 MEETING MINUTES**

The Lancaster Township Board of Supervisors meeting was called to order by Chairman Plesniak at 6:11 pm. Those in attendance were Supervisor Tim Zinkham, Township Manager Ben Kramer, Secretary-Treasurer, Chrissy Senft, Township Solicitor Chris Reese, Township Engineer Tom Thompson, Connie Domhoff, Randy Anno, Kathy Ligday, Mary Ann Brill, Charles Scott, John Meyer, Darrell Fassinger, Bryan Domhoff, Mike Woodward, and Dennis Kerr. Supervisor Kniess was absent.

A discussion was held with Kathy Ligday of the Historical Society regarding insurance coverage of the rental space on Perry Highway. Secretary-Treasurer Chrissy Senft will verify coverage with CW Howard to verify the coverage of historical items.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Zelienople Public Library -A motion was made by Supervisor Zinkham to appoint Jane Klimsauskas to serve as the Lancaster Township representative at the Zelienople Public Library, motion was seconded by Chairman Plesniak and passed by a majority vote. VOTE: Zinkham, Plesniak -YES, Supervisor Kniess was absent.

2020 Truck Upfit – A motion was made by Supervisor Zinkham to approve A&H equipment to complete the upfit of the Chevrolet 3500 at a price of \$32,095.00. Township Roadmaster Mike Spiker enjoyed the past experience of A&H when the Ford 550 was completed, and highly recommended their staff. Motion was seconded by Chairman Plesniak and passed by a majority vote. VOTE: Zinkham, Plesniak – YES, Supervisor Kniess was absent.

Police Probation – A motion was made by Supervisor Zinkham to remove Sean Murphy from the patrolman probation rate of \$17.00 per hour to the rate of \$21.07 an hour per the 2019-2023 Collective Bargaining Agreement, motion was seconded by Chairman Plesniak and passed by a majority vote. VOTE: Zinkham, Plesniak -YES, Supervisor Kniess was absent.

A motion was made by Chairman Plesniak to recess the regular meeting of the Lancaster Township Board of Supervisors at 6:15PM and proceed to a public hearing to be held to review Ordinance 110 and the codification of all Lancaster Township legislation. Seconded by Supervisor Zinkham. VOTE: Zinkham, Plesniak -YES, Supervisor Kniess was absent.

Chairman Plesniak again opened the regular meeting of the Lancaster Township Board of Supervisors meeting at 6:35 and called for a motion to approve Ordinance 110, an ordinance to codify, repeal, and save from repeal all legislation of Lancaster Township. Seconded by Supervisor Zinkham and passed by a majority vote. VOTE: Zinkham, Plesniak -YES, Supervisor Kniess was absent.
